The publishing Coordinator will be a key member of Vizazi Uganda, reporting to the National Ministry Director. The Publishing Coordinator's role at Vizazi Uganda includes developing innovative training program materials for children's ministry leaders, creating culturally relevant Bible teaching resources, marketing and selling these materials, managing a team, and ensuring continuous improvement of published resources.

Specifically, the Publishing Coordinator will...

- Refine, and develop Vizazi Uganda Model Children's Worker training materials and Bible resources.
- Lead in implementing publishing strategies that reflect Vizazi Uganda's mission, and values.
- Develop an effective National ministry publishing team within the country
- Publicize and sell all materials developed by the publishing team
- Work with the publishing team to identify the needs of the National ministry, then develop and implement needed programs.
- Work with the Leadership Development team to realize a growing number of Model Children Workers in the Country.
- Monitor and evaluate the success of the Published programs/projects, through goal setting, designing surveys, and analyzing data.
- Coordinate with churches to organize special activities with children e.g. Bible camps, children evangelism, seminars, etc.
- Develop and maintain a functional database for all publishing materials
- Work with the National Director to develop a ministry whose operations are funded by the local Christian community
